Overview

Santa Cruz Mountains Trail Stewardship is hiring an Events & Community Outreach Coordinator to serve as the face of our organization at community events, fundraising activities, and educational presentations throughout Santa Cruz County. This position is ideal for an outgoing, organized professional who enjoys connecting with diverse audiences and representing our mission in the community.

The Events & Community Outreach Coordinator will report to the Senior Community Engagement Manager and work closely with all departments, serving as SCMTS's primary representative at external events while managing the logistical backbone that makes all organizational events successful. This role combines public-facing community engagement with behind-the-scenes event coordination.

Key Responsibilities

Community Representation & Outreach (40%)

- Represent SCMTS at community events, job fairs, fundraising events, and public presentations
- Present to schools, community groups, and partner organizations about trail stewardship and volunteer opportunities
- Manage tabling activities at festivals, farmers markets, and community gatherings
- Engage diverse audiences in conversations about trail access, environmental stewardship, and volunteer opportunities
- Support donor cultivation events and fundraising activities
- Build relationships with community partners and potential volunteers

Event Logistics & Coordination (35%)

- Coordinate procurement, delivery, and setup of food and beverages for all organizational events
- Manage organizational supply inventory including tents, tables, marketing materials, and event equipment
- Transport, set up, and break down event materials for both trail events and community outreach activities
- Coordinate event logistics across departments (Programs, Development, Marketing)
- Maintain and organize event supply storage areas and equipment
- Prepare promotional materials and raffles for events

Supply Management & Operations (15%)

- Maintain comprehensive inventory of organizational event supplies and materials
- Order and coordinate delivery of event hospitality items from various vendors
- Clean, maintain, and organize event equipment and supplies
- Track event-related expenditures and coordinate with Finance on budget management
- Coordinate supply needs across all departments
- Ensure proper storage and maintenance of organizational equipment

Cross-Departmental Support (10%)

- Support Development team with donor events and fundraising activities
- Assist Marketing team with community event promotion and materials distribution
- Coordinate with Programs team on major events like National Trails Day
- Provide logistical support for board meetings, staff events, and special initiatives
- Assist with organizational photography and social media content at events
- Support special projects and organizational priorities as needed
